Although we provide as much training and support to our team members as we can, it is the individual workers responsibility to report any dangerous occurrence that could potential injure themselves or any other persons surrounding them.

All injuries whether minor or serious must all be reported to a member of the Management Team. These accident reports are vital in order to continually monitor and update our Health and Safety policy. For this reason they must be as truthful and extensive as possible so that measures can be put in place to ensure no future re-occurrence.
